

2009-2010 JUNIOR HIGH SUPPLY LIST

Required:

- A 3-ring **binder, Trapper Keeper, notebook**, ... for holding papers and assignments
- At least 6 **dividers** for the binder (either tabbed dividers or folders that are 3-hole-punched to fit into the binder), OR 6 folders with pockets--one for each academic class, for papers that are not 3-hole punched
- Mechanical or wooden **pencils** with erasers (*absolutely required for the English, math & social studies classes*) AND
 - A small **pencil sharpener** that "stores" the pencil shavings IF you use wooden pencils OR
 - Extra **pencil lead** IF you use mechanical pencils
- A couple of **red pens or pencils** for correcting papers in class
- Colored pencils** (an 8 or 12 pack is fine)
- A **pencil pouch or box** to store your pencils, pens, glue stick, eraser, calculator, etc.
- Loose leaf notebook** paper, either wide or college ruled—not **spiral bound, but the "clean tear" bound is OK
- A **gluestick**
- Composition books**, wide or college ruled—required for English, Social Studies, science, and Algebra I (Plan on using 2 comp books for each class)
- A **student planner**—the bigger, the better because you need room to write down all your assignments
- Athletic shoes with non-mark soles** for Physical Education
- Cloth or paper (non-adhesive!) **book covers** for your English, Math, Science and History books
- A **Bible** (Old & New Testament) - either New International Version or New American Standard Version preferred, but any English translation is fine
- A scientific calculator for Algebra I students only (recommended: a solar Texas Instruments model TI-30 as it will be sufficient for most of your high school math and science classes as well)
- Graph Paper** for Algebra I students by chapter 3

Optional but Highly Recommended:

- A **white block eraser** or a **white stick eraser** in a holder - these erase very cleanly
- Correction tape** or fluid to correct ink pen errors
- A small **stapler** and staples
- A small paperback **dictionary** or a free dictionary on your iTouch or Android phone
- A pair of blunt-nosed **scissors**

Do Not Get:

- ✓ Felt pen markers or gel pens
- ✓ Ink pens in colors other than blue, black or red
- ✓ **Spiral notebooks to use for assignments—the teachers and janitor all agree that the little "fuzzy" edges are too messy

NOTE: Other supplies may be required later in some classes and should be communicated in those classes
