



Activity programs sponsored by the school have an impact on the overall budget. Coaches and directors are hired to oversee these programs outside of the regular school day and are paid a stipend for these responsibilities. Although activity fees will not cover all of the stipends and activity expense, they will help offset the cost to the school.

Activity fees will be assessed for any sport that competes against opposing schools from grade 5<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> and for participation in a high school drama production.

- **High School:** Students participating in a high school sport or drama production will pay \$50 per activity.
- **Elementary/Middle School:** Students participating in a sport for grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> will pay \$25 per sport.
- **Annual Student Maximum:** Total annual fees for any one student will be capped at \$100 for high school and \$50 for middle school.
- **Annual Family Maximum:** Total annual fees for any one family will be capped at \$200.
- **Payment:** Fees will be collected by the business office through the FACTS program after the teams/cast have been selected for that sport/production.
