	 Recommendation Form from a family acquaintance, if student has not been to

	Recent student picture or snapshot – may be an informal photo
	Student Applicant Questionnaire – required for students entering 6 th -12 th grade
	Signed Handbook Acceptance and Spiritual Life Agreement – required for students entering 6 th -12 th grade
