

Our extended day program is designed to offer families an affordable option which allows students to be dropped off early and picked up late from their school day. These services are offered to middle school and elementary aged students with a discounted rate for families with multiple students enrolled. In our morning session, students will have the opportunity to practice relationship building skills as we encourage students to spend time reading, crafting or playing games together before school. Before being dismissed to classes, students will engage in a short devotional and prayer time to help them start their day off on the right path!
