Knights Volleyball ends 2017 season with a 7-4 record, advancing to the 2<sup>nd</sup> round playoffs of the Class 2A Northwest League.

Columbia Christian volleyball achieved an impressive season in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of class 2A. The Lady Knights ended their regular season 7-4 in league play and finished in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in their division, earning a berth in the Northwest League playoffs.
