KNITTING

Knitting is a craft that is unique, relaxing, and portable. With such a wide variety of patterns, yarns, needle sizes, and stitches you can create so many amazing things! Come join us as we learn the basics of knitting. You will get to learn the foundational stitches needed to make most patterns, explore the variety of yarns and tools available, and decipher knitting patterns. By the end of the class you should be able to cast on a project, knit, purl, increase, decrease, bind off a project, create pom poms, and read and follow beginner knitting patterns.

EMBROIDERY

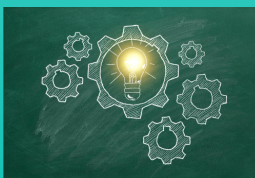

Embroidery is like coloring with thread. Our goal for participants is to complete a series of stitches in the form of a sampler. This can be used a reference when moving into other embroidery projects. Students will be taught the straight stitch, back stitch, lazy daisy, chain stitch, and French knot. This class is tailored to keep everyone engaged. We're not rushing through... we are going to enjoy the process and each other.

ROBOTICS

In the robotics class, we will be offering insight and activities that introduce beginner level coding, computer science, and engineering to our students. We will be using a small robot car that is loaded with sensors to perform programmed tasks. These tasks will introduce the students to working in teams, preparation and planning of a task, and hands-on problem solving. No previous experience is necessary. It is our goal that your child gains confidence through the activities and finds excitement in a challenging environment.
