APPLICATION PROCESS

Columbia Christian provides need-based financial aid to qualifying families. Assistance is awarded for one school year and is based on results from a FACTS Grant and Aid application: factsmgt.com/aid. A new application must be submitted each year. A maximum of 40% can be awarded per student and is subject to fund availability. Award may not stack with other discounts/scholarships and only applies to full-time students from Kindergarten through 12th grade. The priority application deadline is May 1, 2026.

SCHOLARSHIP

Aside from the need-based financial aid provided by Columbia Christian, the school is pleased to partner with the Children's Scholarship Fund-Oregon (CSF) to connect children of low-income families with additional tuition assistance in grades K-8.
